Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost?

The registration fee is \$300. This helps us defray some of the expenses of the workshops. However, no qualified person will be turned away due to a lack of funds. If you would like to obtain a fee waiver, please write us a letter explaining your situation.

Where do I stay?

The program will be held in Washington, D.C. KARAMAH will not cover participants' living expenses, but can help you find housing and make reservations. Please let us know as early as possible whether you need help in finding a place. We will try to obtain a group rate for the participants who have applied by the registration deadline.

How long is the program?

The program lasts for three weeks from June 7 to 25, 2010. Seminars are from 9 am to 5 pm, including breaks for lunch, refreshments, and prayers. Participants are required to attend all sessions.

Can I get course credit?

LLSP provides a series of lectures on Islamic law and leadership that may qualify as introductory courses on the subjects. Although we intend to in the near future, we have not negotiated credit for its courses with surrounding universities. We are happy, however, to help a student obtain credit for our courses by providing the necessary information to her department.

What do I have to do to register?

Please submit the attached application, a r sum , a writing sample, list of 3 references, school transcripts (if you graduated within the last 5 years) and a statement of interest explaining why you wish to attend the 2010 Law and Leadership Summer Program.
